A Note From Pastor Mark

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past month we have spent a number of the our weekends speaking of the Holy Spirit. Pastor David Langseth, who preached at SOTP on the weekend of June 15 and 16 asked us where might we find the Holy Spirit. He proclaimed to us that the best place to find the Spirit is in each one of us.

The beginning of Acts tells of the disciples waiting around in Jerusalem, after their last moments with their master teacher, for the gift of Holy Spirit baptism to come from God, just as Jesus told them (Acts 1:4). It has been seven weeks since Easter morning. Jesus has returned from the dead and assured them of his promises, and then left mysteriously by ascending into heaven in a cloud.

With all these events the disciples are probably perplexed about what they should do and where they should be. As God's great timing and staging unveils, this week just happens to be the same week as several Jewish festivals: Pentecost, which Jews celebrate 50 days after Passover; Shavuot; and Feast of Weeks. According to the dictionary, these holidays commemorate as well, the revelation of the Law on Mount Sinai and the celebration of the wheat festival in ancient times. Thus, a multitude of Jews from all over the known world have gathered in the holy city of Jerusalem for celebration and worship.

Onto this stage comes the small group (120 according to Acts 1:15) of disciples of Jesus, perhaps the latest "new" religion to rise up in Jerusalem.

As they are gathered, sitting together in one house, God sends a gift. And they are overwhelmed with the power, the wisdom, the knowledge God gives. They are filled upon seeing the fire and hearing the strong wind. They pour into the streets, using languages they had not known before, telling the wonders of God. Peter is empowered to explain the happenings culminating in thousands of converts, and the Christian Church, the Body of Christ, is launched.

So what happens to the Holy Spirit today? Where have you seen the Spirit active? Any miracles? What action does the Holy Spirit cause within you? Do you believe the power of God's gift? Will it make a difference in your life?

I encourage you to share a story with someone close to you about how the Spirit was revealed to you in your life. For it is in each one of us that the Spirit is best found.

We'll begin with those biblical writings known as "Wisdom Literature": some of the Psalms; Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and

And then on Saturday, September 28, we'll be offering Bible 101, the fourth edition! This is when we explore the basics of the Bible--the who, what, where, why, and how--this Holy Book came

Ministry Musings

This past weekend, I attended the Northern Illinois Synod Assembly. What a joy! I caught up with old friends, met some new ones, got to know my fellow SOTP delegates better, shared fellowship and worship, found out much about our synod and the "churchwide" ELCA and where it is going and what it is doing, and learned much about faith.



Our keynote speaker was Anna Madsen, an ELCA pastor who calls herself a "theologian-at- large". Anna lost her husband in an accident about 13 years ago and her son, Karl, who was three at the time, suffered a traumatic brain injury in the accident. She also had an 8month-old baby girl. Anna and her children have built a new life for themselves. They live in northern Minnesota and Anna operates the OMG: Center for Theological Conversation and The Spent Dandelion Theological Retreat Center.

To say Anna was an engaging and thought-provoking speaker would

be an understatement. She challenged all of us to think outside of our well-defined theological boxes and to strive to see our lives and the lives of those around us in a new way.

One of the themes that she spoke about was "God's plan". I was brought up hearing that God had a plan for my life and I just needed to follow it. For quite a while now, especially since my husband died so suddenly, I've questioned the notion that God has a specific plan for my life. I believe he has a purpose for my life, to glorify him; but that he has a precise and detailed plan that he moves me through as if he were a puppeteer just doesn't fit the God I know. If that were true, where does my free choice come in? And what do I do about things like school shootings, child pornography, 911, the Holocaust, and so many other terrible things that take place in this broken world? Is it really "God's plan" that a child is kidnapped and tortured, or that a person walks into a place of worship and kills those worshiping him there? Was the devastation of 911, or the weather-related events, or the horrors of the Holocaust part of God's plan for the people involved?

I don't believe it is! I believe those things are the result of either bad choices made by people or simply the results of living in a broken world. In her address, Anna suggested anything that we have to say about God must be said in Auschwitz! That really caught my attention and challenged me to think! I can't say that God caused Auschwitz because it was part of God's plan! But I can say that God loved those prisoners and felt their pain; God cried their tears; God walked alongside them to the gas chambers; God was just as outraged as we in America were when we saw it.

But because God doesn't have a "specific plan" doesn't mean he isn't involved in our lives. Anna used the analogy of God as a fisherman. He casts his line into our lives and uses it to catch our attention and "lure" us in a certain direction. And sometimes we follow it and we go where he leads, and he "catches" us into his will and way. Other times we begin to follow the lure and something else catches our attention... "squirrel!" ... and off we swim after the distraction. Other times we may not even see the lure and swim in a way that isn't God's intention. But the good news is...God NEVER gives up. He follows where we go and casts his line again and again, trying to catch our attention and leading us in his direction from wherever we are; and we again have the option to follow, get distracted, or swim away. He NEVER stops working to catch our attention and lure us into his intentions.

GRIEF JOURNEY CONTINUES


