Dear Friends at Shepherd of the Prairie Lutheran Church:



As we enter into our stewardship drive this year, let's think about all the ways we see generosity and abundance. Let's take time to "look and listen."



# Ministry Musings With Donna

Pass It On

"It only takes a spark
to get a fire going

And soon all those around
can warm up in its glowing

That's how it is with God's love
once you experience it

You spread his love to everyone you
want to pass it on." Kurt Kaiser

Many of you may remember this song; it was a staple in the congregation where I worshipped during the 70s and 80s and even into the 90s. The song goes on to talk about how once we know God's love we are inspired to "shout it from the mountain tops". We are compelled to share the Good News, not because it's what we are "supposed" to do, but because we can't help but want to share that God has come to us and claimed us as

God's own.

I was reading today about the early Christians and how they banded together in small groups of home churches where they worshipped, ate meals, told their life stories, prayed and shared the Eucharist. They built communities of passing God's love on, to each other and to those they invited in.

I suddenly had a picture in my head of a dark church on Christmas Eve; the only light coming from one candle at the front of the church. Then the pastor walks to the Christ candle and lights theirs; now there are two lights burning. The ushers move to the light and now there are 4, now 6,now 8. AS they move down the aisles, the

candles are lit and the light spreads from person to person until all candles are lit and the church is aglow with candlelight.

. "That's how it is with God's love, one you've experienced it." You want others to be part of the light, the glow of God's love; and you and I pass it on. We can pass it on through words, through acts of love and compassion, through inviting others and by joining together to learn, share and build community.



As summer becomes fall, we are quickly wrapping up on framing work at Elm and adding color to our build with tan and white siding and a purple Fire Separation Wall. The Fire Separation Wall has been completed.

The remaining walls enclosing the Fire Wall have been completed and last Saturday, the second stair case was installed. Siding for the first floor is complete on 3 walls. Soffits have been completed for the garage walls and gables. And most importantly, AT&T finally moved the guy wire blocking the driveway and planned route for the water and sewer connections.

- Install attic insulation baffles
- Complete drywall framing nailers

This facility will ease our storage needs and save SOTP both off-sight storage fees and insurance coverage over the long run. Thank you to the Facilities Team for steering this project to completion. As we all know, the cost of labor and materials has increased since the pandemic has affected our economy. The final project cost are exceeding our initial budgeted amount. About 70% of this project cost has been covered by the Facilities Team ability to save SOTP cost over

years. That has left 30% of the cost to be covered by the General Operating Fund, slightly more than what has been planned for. The Finance Team is comfortable with

covering these expenditures with our General Operating Fund reserves. We will be adding the Storage Garage Fund to the online electronic giving link for your convenience.
